Tours are offered each week on a first-come, first-served basis with a maximum of 70 people. In the first hour, groups take a guided tour of the island, including Perry's Lookout, the glacial grooves, Stone Lab buildings and the outside of Cooke Castle. The second hour focuses on Lake Erie research currently being conducted at Stone Lab.

To get to Gibraltar, meet the water taxi at the Boardwalk Restaurant dock 15 minutes prior to the tour time (\$6 round trip, payable to boat driver).

The Aquatic Visitors Center offers people of all ages the chance to explore Lake Erie's complex ecosystem through hands-on activities and tanks containing live fish. Children under 16 can borrow fishing gear and fish for free off the 100-foot pier. Private group tours may be scheduled May-October.

Visit the South Bass Island Lighthouse, located at the southern tip of South Bass Island, which is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Learn about its history and the area's historical shipwrecks. The top of the lighthouse tower offers a great view of the island.

Lighthouse grounds are open to the public daily from dawn to dusk free of charge, unless otherwise posted.
