One tour is offered each week on a first-come, first-served basis with a maximum of 70 people. In the first hour, groups take a guided tour of the island, including Perry's Lookout, the glacial grooves, Stone Lab buildings and the outside of Cooke Castle. The second hour focuses on Lake Erie research currently being conducted at Stone Lab.

SOUTH BASS ISLAND LIGHTHOUSE

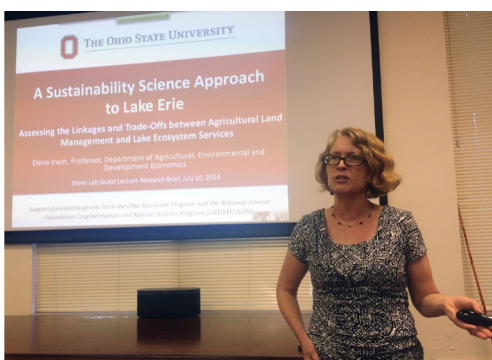

Visit the South Bass Island Lighthouse, located at the southern tip of South Bass Island, which is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Learn about its history and the area's shipwrecks. Visit the top of the lighthouse tower for a great view of the island. Lighthouse grounds are open to the public daily from dawn to dusk unless otherwise posted.
