





### **Walleye Abundance**




#### **Walleye Harvest and Effort**






#### **Walleye Fishing Rates**




### 2018 Walleye Forecast – Excellent


- Population increasing with most sub-legal fish now legal

  - 2003 Hatch trophy fish




#### Yellow Perch Abundance




# **Yellow Perch Sport Harvest**






# **Yellow Perch Sport Harvest**





#### **Yellow Perch Sport Harvest Rate**






#### **2018 Yellow Perch Forecast**


- Below previous highs, expect similar conditions to 2017
- Catch dominated by 10-11" fish (Ages 4 and 6)
- No change in bag limits

#### **Smallmouth Bass**


- Catch dominated by 6 year old fish in Central Basin
- Older fish providing trophy opportunities

#### Largemouth Bass

High catch rates with ~2 fish/hr in 2017



### Steelhead



#### **Lake Trout**

- 2012: stocking locations were expanded in to the Central and Western Basins in Lake Erie
- 2017: reports of fish in the Grand, Rocky, and other tributaries
  - Rare event throughout the Great Lakes
  - First time report of a river run lake trout in Lake Erie
  - Timing coincides with the spawning season of this species and age at maturity (5 years of age)
