Summary of Duties

The Dining and Residence Lead serves as the direct supervisor for the coordinators. They manage a rotating housing schedule for dorms and cottages, including logistics and cleaning, as well as the day-to-day operations of a commercial kitchen serving up to 100 people, such as ordering supplies, budget and expense monitoring and participating in meetings with the rest of the Stone Lab staff.

Coordinators assist with all day-to-day operations of Stone Lab's dining and residence operations, including housekeeping. These positions require excellent customer service skills while serving meals to students, staff and guests of Stone Lab.
