# FEATURED FISH:

## Sea lamprey, on loan from the Great Lakes Fishery Commission

Sea lamprey are one of the most notorious invasive species in the Great Lakes. These Atlantic Ocean natives were in Lake Ontario as early as 1835, but were prevented from entering Lake Erie by Niagara Falls. They made their Lake Erie debut in 1921 after the construction of the Welland Canal. Sea lamprey use their raspy teeth to make holes in the sides of fish and feed on their bodily fluids. Affected fish die from blood loss or infection. Today, sea lamprey population in the Great Lakes is controlled with lampricide applied to the rivers and streams where they spawn.
