ERIE ISLAND CRUISE

Take a boat tour of the island area, learning some Lake Erie facts along the way. The trip concludes with a fish trawl (weather permitting) highlighting the identification of local fishes.

AVC TOUR & FISHING FUN

Get a guided tour of the Aquatic Visitors
Center and learn about its past as a historic
fish hatchery. View our live fish and macro
invertebrate displays before grabbing a
fishing pole and some bait to try your luck
from our dock.

BIRDS FOR BEGINNERS

WATER QUALITY WALK

Put on some boots and grab some nets to sample for macro invertebrate animals in Lake Erie and learn how scientists use them as indicators of water quality.

Learn the external and internal anatomy of different local fishes and use a dichotomous key to identify fish families.

REPTILES AND AMPHIBIANS

Learn about the characteristics of reptiles and amphibians and get a hands-on look at different animals from the island region.
