This course is designed for anyone with a general interest in birds and is aimed at newcomers to birding and ornithology. The course will be primarily taught in the field to take advantage of the height of spring migration. The workshop will be based out of the Kelleys Island Field Station, providing students access to a migration hotspot as well as an active bird banding research site.
